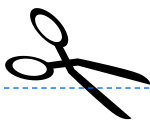

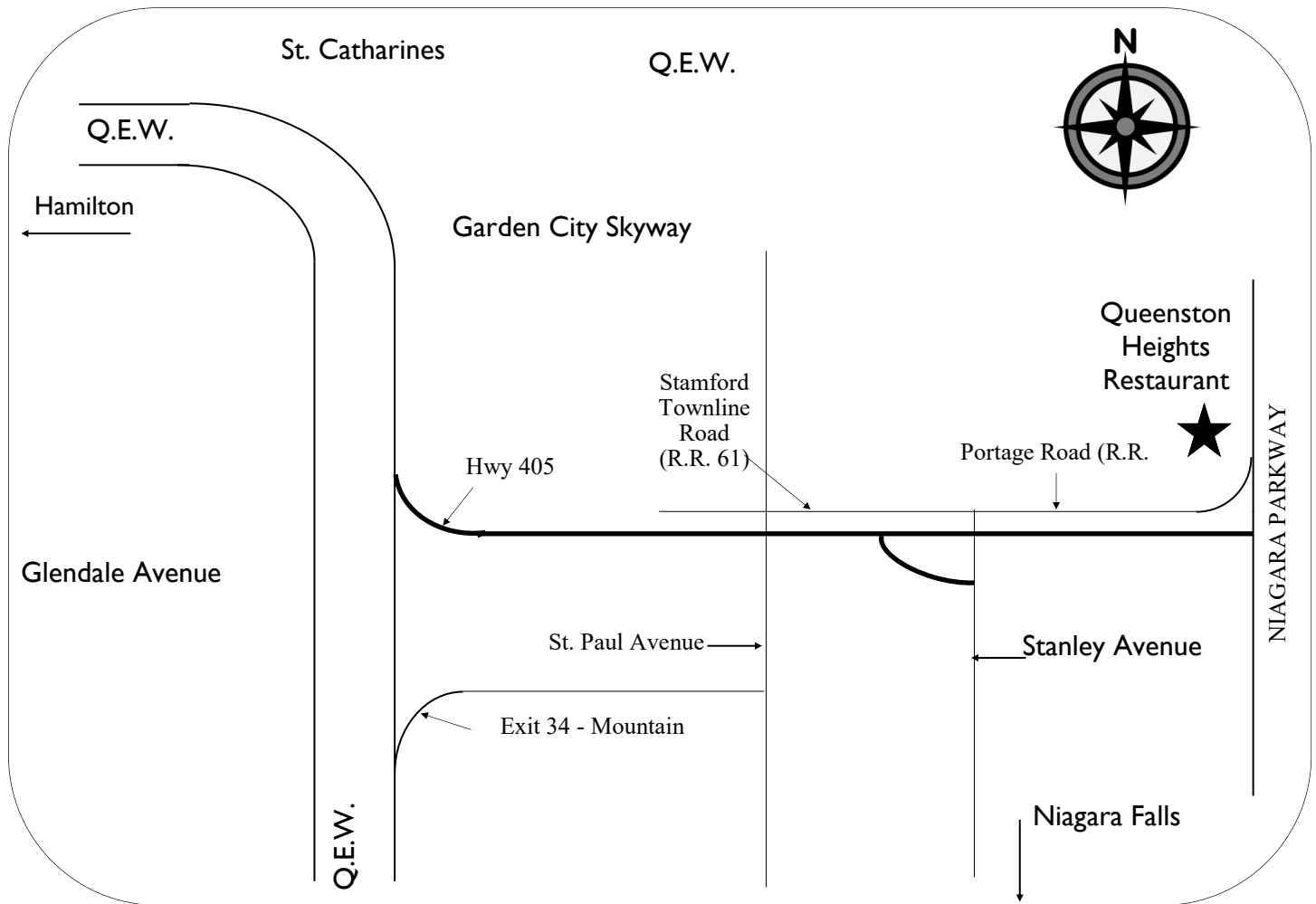

DIRECTIONS

From the Grimsby, Lincoln, and St. Catharines

1. Take the Niagara-bound Q.E.W. over the Garden City Skyway.
2. Exit from the left lane onto Highway 405 (General Brock Parkway).
3. Exit at Stanley Avenue.
4. Turn left onto Stanley Avenue and cross over the 405.
5. Turn right onto Portage Road (Regional Road 61).
6. At the roundabout take the 3rd exit leading to the Queenston Heights Restaurant.

From Fort Erie, Niagara Falls, Port Colborne, Welland, West Lincoln

1. Take the best route to the Q.E.W. Toronto-bound (North).
2. Exit the Q.E.W. at Mountain Road (Exit 34).
3. Remain on Mountain Road through the roundabout (2nd exit).
4. Turn left onto St. Paul Avenue.
5. Turn right onto Niagara/Stamford Townline Road (Regional Road 61).
6. Use the middle lane to turn slightly left onto Portage Road (R.R. 61).
7. At the roundabout take the 3rd exit leading to the Queenston Heights Restaurant.

NOTE: For those who would prefer a scenic route, the Queenston Heights Restaurant can also be reached from the Niagara Parkway.
